Uruguay

Catamayor Viognier Reserve, £19.25
San José
The delicate aromas of lychee and peach introduce the wild honey and stone fruit flavours with a lingering creamy finish. This is a family owned Vineyard.



South Africa

Beaumont Hope Marguerite £21.15
Barrel-Fermented Chenin Blanc, Walker Bay
This is the flagship wine from the Beaumont family and winner of the Decanter World Wine Awards 2009 International Trophy for best varietal. A great food wine, with hints of ripe green apples, dried apricot and almonds.



New Zealand

Green Lip Sauvignon Blanc, £5.25 £7.00 £19.95
Marlborough
An outstanding Sauvignon Blanc from the family owned Jackson Estate in South Island creating a fusion of Tropical fruits balanced with fresh acidity. Just what you would expect from a New Zealand wine.



Kidnapper Bay Chardonnay, £22.00

Le Bel Olivier, £3.90 £5.20 £14.50
Grenache-Merlot, IGP, Pays d'Oc, Languedoc
Grenache-Merlot make a juicy easy drinking red with soft tannins and good fruit content.



Louis Latour Pinot Noir £19.95
Domaine du Valmoissine, Vin de Pays Côteaux du Verdon
It is so soft and silky, with such a purity of fruit and so much finesse that few Burgundians would believe this is not a Burgundy, and a fine one at that!



Robert Skalli £18.25
Cabernet Sauvignon, Vin de Pays D'Oc
Blackcurrant and bilberry notes fill the nose as powerful aromas of dark berries, pepper and coriander give ample, well-structured flavour.



Château Petit Bois, Lussac St. Emilion, £19.50
Dulong, Bordeaux
Rich, red fruit aroma that is bursting with cherries and wild berries on the palate.



Argentina £15.95
Goyenechea Winery Merlot/Syrah, Mendoza
This wine is a wonderful 50:50 blend of Syrah and Merlot, it is medium bodied with delicious dark fruit flavours. This wine is a perfect match for red meat dishes and cheese.



Uruguay £17.50
Catamayor Merlot/Tannat, San José
The soft plummy flavours of merlot and Tannat, the grape Uruguay is famous for, combine to produce a rich, full bodied red with great length. This is a family owned Vineyard.



South Africa £20.50
Beaumont Ariane, Walker Bay
Named after the daughter of the family vineyard owners, this classic Bordeaux blend is a rich deep colour with herbs, fruit and chocolate aromas. Winner of numerous awards including 4 stars in the John Platter guide.



Katherine Hills Shiraz £16.95
This fruit driven Shiraz is full of concentrated plums and blackcurrants. A hint of white pepper adds a warming spice to the finish.



Spain £19.75
Finca Constancia, Vine de la Tierra de Casti
Smoky, roasty, 'barbecue' nose, with big tannins on the palate, fruit bubbling under heroically. This Shiraz/Cabernet plus Cabernet Franc, Tempranillo and Graciano needing two or three years in maturity, is perfect now for drinking.



Viña Real, Rioja, Crianza £4.85 £6.40 £18.50
Aged for 12 – 24 months in American Oak casks before bottling, this wine has aromas of Morello cherry, raspberries and toasted vanilla with an elegant long finish.

Champagne & Sparkling

France

Chimère, Brut £30.00
A quality dry Champagne with lemony, biscuity flavours, fine bubbles and a touch of ageing.

Marquis de la Cour, £18.95
Sparkling Rosé, Vin Mousseux
With a pale pink colour, this wine has fine bubbles. Supple with fruity finish, it has a red fruit aroma.
